- Emergencies with immediate need: Please call the above number, and your call will be returned as soon as possible.
- Food donations: There continues to be a great need for food for the local food pantries during this pandemic. You may bring your food donations and place them in the food cart in the vestibule.
- Financial Contributions: During this time of crisis, we continue to have bills and financial obligations. If you give via the Sunday collection, many of you mail your contributions to the parish office at 816 West Broad Street, Horseheads, New York 14845. I thank you for your continued financial support. If you visit the chapel, there is a box in the vestibule where you can drop your contribution. This might be a good time for you to enroll in our electronic giving program.
