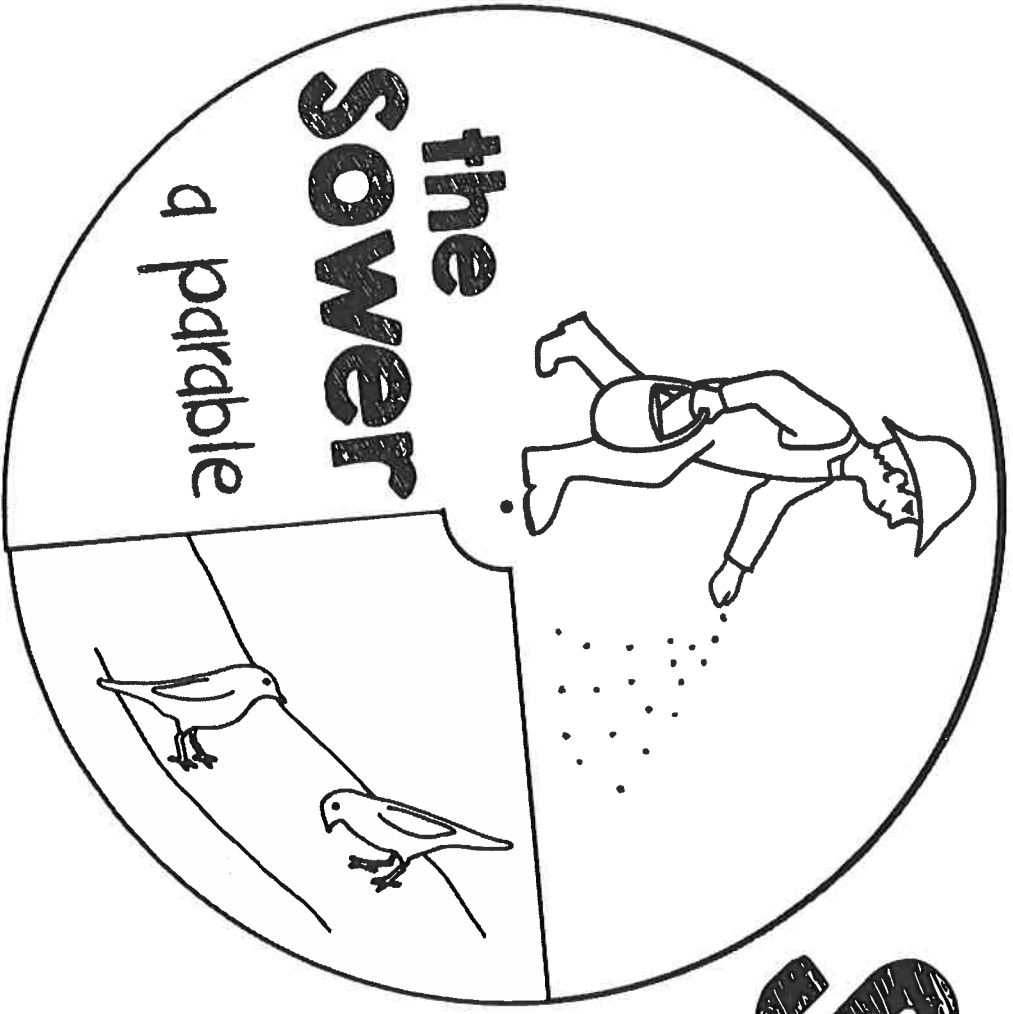

Story Wheel



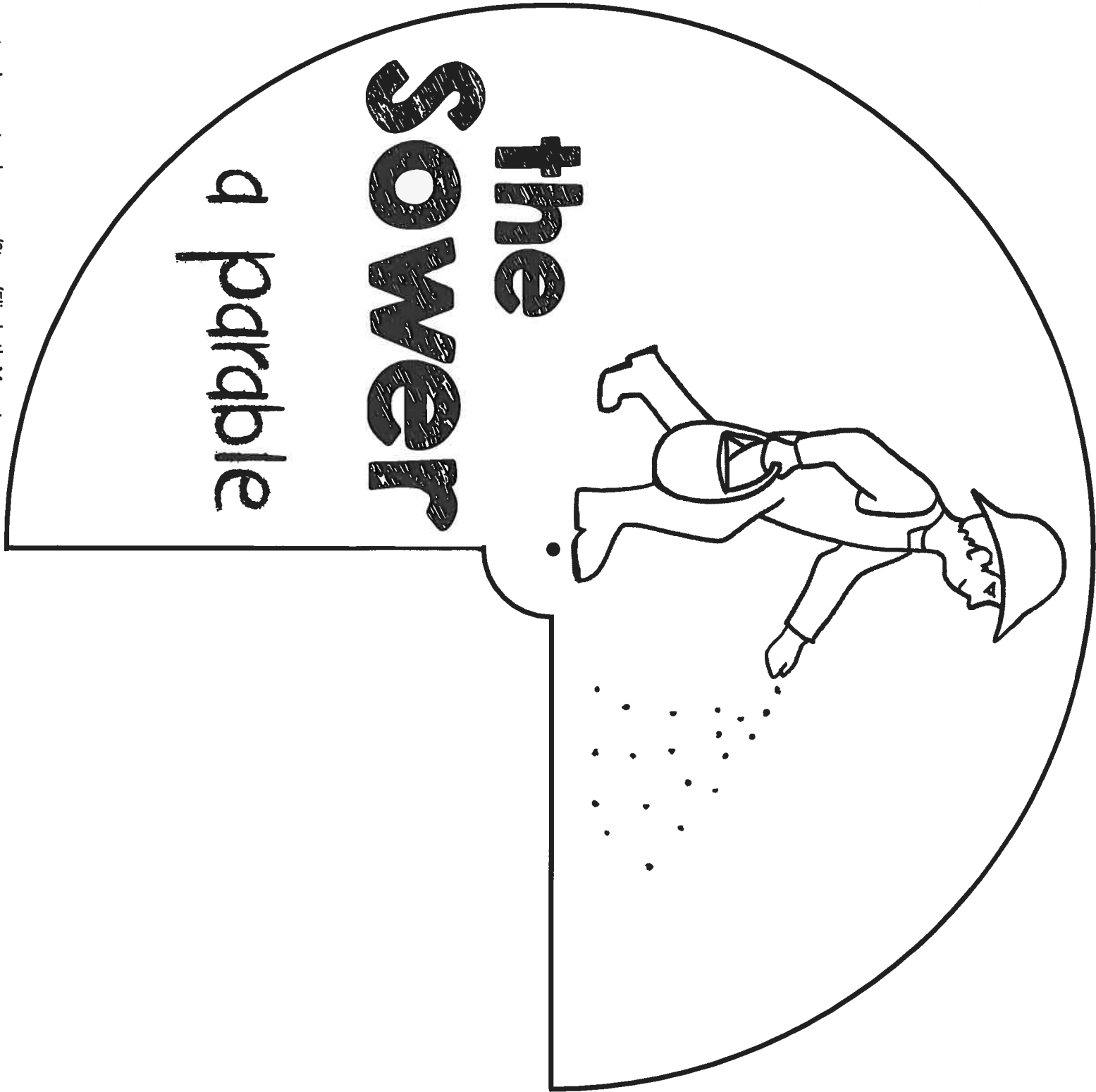
Instructions

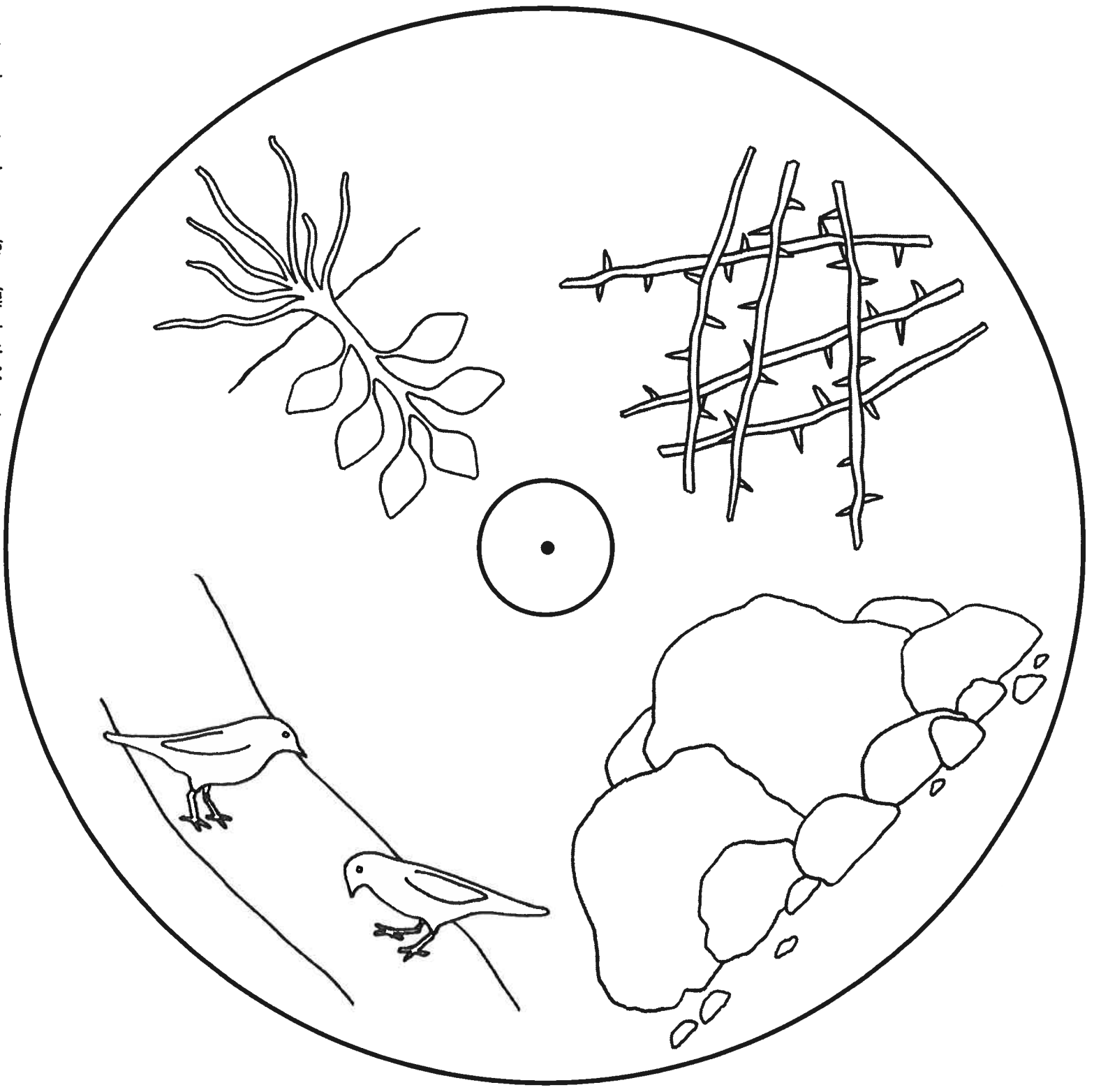
1. Print both pages on card stock.
2. Decorate (if using the B&W template).
3. Cut both out on outside line.
4. Poke hole in middle of both (on the dot) with pin or sharp scissors.
5. Insert a brass brad (split pin) through the hole, affixing the top of the wheel to the bottom.
6. When you turn the top, you will see one scene at a time through the opening.

To Use

1. Read the Parable of the Sower found in Matthew 13, Mark 4, and Luke 8.
2. Have students color and assemble their Sower wheel.
3. Students use the Sower wheel to re-tell the story elements.

The Parable of the Sower may help your students intentionally prepare their hearts to hear God's word!







Parable of the Sower Mosaic: Remember that the seeds need "good rich soil in which to grow". Jesus needs our loving hearts to spread the Good News about Him to others, like the sower spread the seeds. Fill in the outline by gluing different colored seeds to make a mosaic. Popcorn, mustard seeds, cloves, bird seed or cereal are some ideas from around the house.
