PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE:

A number of years ago, our parish added a new method where the parishioners of St. Mary Our Mother could make their regular financial contributions to the parish. JANUARY IS POVERTY AWARENESS MONTH

The number of people experiencing homelessness nationwide on a single night (in 2024) was the highest ever recorded at more than 771,000 people - an increase of 18% from the year before, according to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. During 2025 Catholic Charities provided homeless services to # persons in Chemung and Schuylar counties. The affordable housing crisis is worsening across the nation; inflation is rising, and wages among middle-and lower income households are stagnating causing some worries about mortgage foreclosures. Catholic teaching affirms that decent, safe, and affordable housing is a human right and the Catholic Church recognizes the important role government has along with Catholic Charities, other non-profits, and faith communities in achieving this aspect of the common good. Challenge: Contact our Congressman Nick Langworthy (607-377-3130) ask him to oppose funding cuts for essential federal housing programs and advocate for more investment in affordable housing; and, contact our NYS Senator Tom O'Mara (607-735-9671) ask him to support continued funding for the NYS mortgage foreclosure prevention program (NYS HOPP).

Lent: A Time of Preparation

The holy season of Lent is a special time of personal and spiritual growth. It's a time to reflect on ourselves and others. The spiritual pillars of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving guide us as we strengthen our relationship with God and our neighbors. Our world faces urgent needs as more families struggle with hunger and poverty. The Catholic social teaching principle of solidarity teaches us that we are one human family. Because we are connected, the joys and challenges faced by our sisters and brothers affect us too. (Catholic Relief Services).

This year, **Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18th**. Once again, our parish is adopting the CRS Rice Bowl Lenten Program as our almsgiving outreach to those in need. More information on CRS Rice Bowl will be forthcoming in the weeks to come. We hope you will plan to participate with others in our parish in the Rice Bowl program.

**DIOCESE OF ROCHESTER
PERMENENT DIACONATE**

The deacon is a man of faith, who is called from the community that already recognizes his dedication to service. He makes a lifetime commitment to serving the People of God by proclaiming the Word, assisting and presiding at liturgies, and ministering in the areas of charity and social justice. A deacon gives witness to his availability to the community by addressing present and emerging needs of the Church. The Diocese is inviting interested men of strong and active faith, who can demonstrate a record of service in the communities in which they live, work and worship, who may wish to explore a possible call to ordained ministry as a permanent deacon, to first speak with their pastor for an initial conversation. They may also contact Deacon Edward Giblin, Director of the Office of the Permanent Diaconate, at edward.giblin@dor.org, for additional information. A potential candidate must be at least 35 years of age and no older than 62 years of age at the time of ordination after a five (5) year period of formation. He must be in good health, emotionally mature, have stable relationships and must have the wholehearted support of his wife (if married) and family to enter the phase of inquiry. Because the parish is the primary experience of Church for most inquirers, the parish community is asked as well to invite from among its members men who exhibit strong faith and a spirit of service and encourage them to consider a possible vocation to the permanent diaconate. The Diocese anticipates that the next formation class will begin in Fall 2027, with the application process beginning in early 2027.
