

PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

The annual Catholic Ministries Appeal is well underway! I hope all parishioners will join me in offering a financial gift to this year's appeal. These donations fund the day-to-day operations of the Diocese of Rochester. Without such generosity, the diocese could not continue to support our parishes, including St. Mary Our Mother, and fulfill our mission.

Recently, the Office of Stewardship and Communications forwarded the following article entitled, "How and When Your CMA Gift is Used."

When your gift is received, we utilize it immediately for current operations. The CMA supports offices, personnel and ministries that provide assistance and resources to parishes, pastors, parish ministers, and Pastoral and Financial Councils through such offices as Information Safe Environment, Technology, Evangelization and Catechesis, Pastoral Services, Finance, Building/Property Management, Stewardship Communications, the Tribunal, and Management. In fact, the CMA funds nearly 60 percent of the current diocesan operating budget in seven key areas:

Serving the poor, the elderly and infirm through Catholic Charities;

providing diocesan-wide services to our parishes and institutions;

educating the young and young adults in the Catholic faith in our schools, parish religious education programs, and on college campuses;

funding the ministries of Bishop Matano, the New York State Catholic conference, United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Vatican;

funding operations & support of the Pastoral Center, including maintenance and capital improvements;

supporting the fundraising efforts of the CMA campaign, such as the cost of mailings, gift and date processing and staffing;

a detailed allocations chart is available at www.dor.org/cma;

all funds raised in the CMA are used for programs, services and ministries. No CMA contributions are used in the settlement of legal cases;

May I ask that you make your pledge to the CMA as soon as possible. If all parishioners participate in this year's appeal, we can achieve our goal of \$122,209. Your gift can be paid in installments through May, 2020.

FROM THE FINANCE COUNCIL

In addition to donating cash or checks, there are other tax beneficial ways that you can donate to St. Mary Our Mother School or Parish.

If you are over age 70-1/2 and you have an IRA retirement account, you may be eligible for a tax benefit called a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). This provision in the tax law allows you to make a distribution from your IRA directly to St. Mary Our Mother. Using the QCD option, you can transfer up to \$100,000 per year to charity and exclude the entire distribution from your gross income for tax purposes. In addition, the distribution can be counted toward your annual Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) that must be withdrawn from your account anyway. This is a nice tax benefit that allows you to reduce your taxable income, regardless of whether yu are otherwise eligible to deduct charitable contributions on yoru tax return. To use the QCD election you will just need to sign a form provided by your IRA account custodian.

In you have appreciated securities, you may be able to save money on capital gains taxes by donating shares to St. Mary Our Mother. You can transfer a stock, bond, mutual fund or exchange traded fund (ETF) position that has appreciated in value, directly to our investment account. We can sell the position for you and use the proceeds. We do not owe capital gains tax on the sale, since we are a qualified non-profit organization. In addition to avoiding capital gains on selling the position, you may also

be able to deduct the value of the security that you donate, as a charitable contribution.

If you hold the appreciated security in a brokerage account, your custodian can provide you with the forms to sign to make the transfer. Please call our parish office for any additional instructions at 607-739-3817.

If you have any questions, or need any clarification, please let us know. We will do everything we can to accommodate and make the donation as easy as possible.
