

#### **PASTER'S PERSPECTIVE:**

Today, we arrive at the Fourth Sunday of Lent, oftentimes referred to as Laetare Sunday or Rejoice Sunday. Lent 2024 is at its midpoint, which makes this a good time to give ourselves a little mid-Lenten checkup. The following are some thoughts that we might like to ponder.

How Faithful have I been to the Lenten disciplines of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving?

Have I taken the time, or made the time, to watch and pray during this Lent?

Have I taken advantage of the many opportunities for

spiritual growth this Lent?

Daily Mass, reading of scripture and Lenten literature, clearing my schedule to participate in some Lenten activities, making the time to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance, joining in the public praying of the Stations of the Cross each Friday in our chapel?

How has the season of Lent helped me to grow in greater awareness of God's special love for me?

On Ash Wednesday, I mentioned that Lent is not only a time of "giving up," but a Season of "giving" as well. In that spirit, a common practice of many during the Lenten season is to practice the corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

#### The Corporal Works of Mercy include:

Feeding the hungry Giving drink to the thirsty Clothing the naked Visiting the imprisoned Sheltering the homeless Visiting the sick Burying the dead

#### The Spiritual Works of Mercy include:

Admonishing sinner Counseling the doubtful Comforting the sorrowful Bearing wrongs spiritually Forgiving injuries Praying for the living and the dead

As you read through these works of mercy let the grace and power of God's grace and spirit touch your mind and heart, and help you to be creative in ways of practicing a number of these works of mercy during these days of the Lenten season.

#### **GOSPEL MEDITATION:**

Our national pastime isn't baseball. It's what the Bible calls "condemning the world." We generally enjoy pronouncing curses upon those whom we see as trouble, wrong, or evil. Don't believe me? Listen to almost any podcast, cable news network, or social media platform to hear it. It will be some version of: "We all agree that if *they* are eradicated, things will be great." Condemning is almost always clothed in virtue. It basks in its good intentions. That's why it is so attractive. Condemning seems like our best path to saving what is good.

What a shock, then, to hear Jesus announce: "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him" (Jn 3:17). He comes to save the world, as we all want, but he will accomplish it without an act of condemnation. How hard it is to accept this! Condemning feels godlike. I judge who and what must be lost to protect the good. But in the light of Jesus' endless mercy and love, this is the *least* godlike thing we can do.

Lenten challenge: This week, I invite you to give up the delicious experience of condemning whomever in the world you most would like to see gone. Perhaps write down their names. Secondly, I invite you to consider fasting from any media that feeds the tasty but deadly tendency to condemn.

#### Parents Just Don't Understand

Anybody remember the old rap song by the Fresh Prince, aka Will Smith, "Parents Just Don't Understand?" As we grow up, it is sometimes a struggle for us to imagine that our parents understand us. We never saw them as children.

We're often feel the same way about God. We gripe about what He asks of us. "He doesn't understand sin, He's allgood,"

He doesn't understand temptation, He is perfect."

In Scripture, God can be very much a father, telling us what we can and cannot do. And yet, in His divine genius, He is sometimes simply a man at a well, asking for a drink.

For me, it turns out I didn't need to tell my parents anything about what I was going through as a kid — they knew already. What I needed was for them to tell me what to do, and how to do it.

Similarly, we don't need to tell God about human nature. We need God to tell us about His nature. He's good enough to ask us for a drink, to enter into our humanity. But we have to remember, for our own sakes, to have the humility to ask Him for something, too — the water that will quench our eternal thirst.
